**Notes:**

Users of power – All electrical leads and electrical equipment must be tested and tagged in accordance with AS3760. Extension leads must also be tagged with owner’s name.

All flexible and extension leads must be supported at least 2m above ground.

Generators – Generators, generator fuels, etc must be in an area not accessible to the general public. Ie- rope off an area as a restricted area.

Food Stalls – Please ensure you have correct insurance and provide all necessary documentation. Food stalls must comply with National Food Safety Standards and abide by all local council regulations and requirements. Food and Drink stalls will be asked to provide a small bin at their site for waste disposal.

**FOOD STALLS WHICH WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED INCLUDE ICECREAMS AND CHEESES. PLEASE ENSURE YOU DO NOT BRING THESE. YOU MAY USE CHEESE OR ICECREAM ON YOUR PRODUCT BUT PLEASE DO NOT SELL AS AN INDIVIDUAL ITEM.**

**FOOD OR DRINK NOT TO BE SOLD IN GLASS.**

No vehicles will remain on site between 7.15am and 3.30pm unless required for trade purposes **and** permission from market organizer has been sought. Road closure begins at 6am and ends at 5pm on Saturday and Sunday.

Setup begins at 6am. If you wish to arrive later than setup time please advise in advance so an appropriate site may be allocated for this. Late arrivers may have a site with a gentle slope or be in the park (walk in).

At close, please be aware pedestrians may still be near the area.
